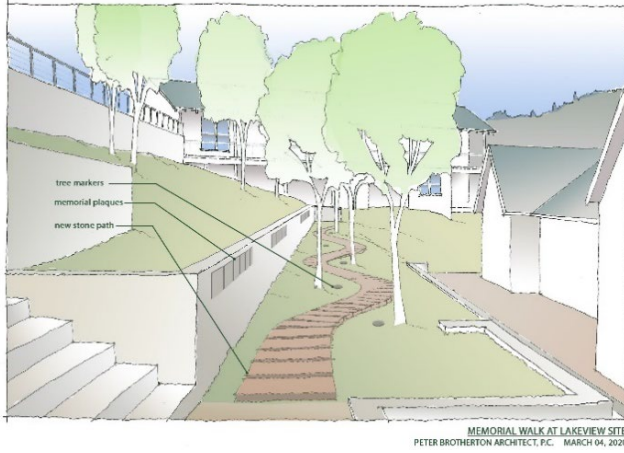


Aspen Grove Fund



In a continued effort to enhance and preserve the green space in Green Mountain Falls, the Historic Green Mountain Falls Foundation planted an aspen grove on the grounds of Lakeview Terrace, off Foster and Howard Streets. A stone walkway was also installed, giving residents of and visitors to Green Mountain Falls the opportunity to commemorate special occasions and honor the important people in their lives through tribute plaques, tree markers, and benches. This may be done through a donation to the Aspen Grove Fund.
